



Energy Solutions Traditional Student Partial Scholarship
USU Tooele Regional Campus
Application for Academic Year 2009/10

The Energy Solutions Traditional Student Partial Scholarship is available to incoming freshman, continuing and transfer undergraduate students who graduated high school Spring 2005 or later. This scholarship is partial tuition only and is only available to students who are Tooele County residents and are attending USU Tooele Regional Campus.

**Students will only be awarded one scholarship/tuition waiver from USU Tooele Regional Campus for the academic year 09-10. If a student is eligible for more than one scholarship/waiver, only the one with the greatest monetary value will be awarded.

To qualify for this award, students must:

- 1. Graduated high school Spring 2005 or later.
2. Be officially admitted to Utah State University and transcripts posted by application deadline of July 31, 2009.
3. Submit High School transcripts with this application.
4. Submit proof of ACT score with this application.
5. Show a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (this award is merit based).
6. Provide proof of Tooele County residency by submitting copy of a current utility bill.
7. Maintain enrollment in a minimum of 6 credits each semester during scholarship period at USU Tooele Regional Campus (repeated courses as well as independent study courses do not qualify).
8. Complete and submit this application to USU Tooele Regional Campus on or before July 31, 2009.

To maintain this award, students must:

- 1. Maintain enrollment in a minimum of 6 credits both semesters at a USU Tooele Regional Campus (repeated courses as well as independent study courses do not qualify).
2. Remain in good standing and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.

Restrictions of the award:

- 1. Award cannot be used with any other USU Tooele Regional Campus scholarship or tuition waiver.
2. Award is good for Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 semesters only.
3. Award is not redeemable for cash refund.
4. Award will be reversed and the student will owe the balance if enrolled eligible credits drop below 6 each semester.
5. Award will discontinue if the cumulative GPA drops below 3.0.
6. Recipient must meet with a Tooele Regional Campus Advisor prior to the award being disbursed.
7. Recipient must compose a thank you letter to this scholarship's sponsor to be reviewed with the Tooele Regional Campus Advisor prior to the award being disbursed.
