



**Life Experience Partial
Scholarship**

The Life Experience Partial Scholarship is for **tuition only** and is only available to students who are attending USU Tooele Regional Campus in a non-concurrent capacity. This scholarship cannot be transferred to Utah State University in Logan or any other Regional Campus or Education Center. This scholarship is awarded based on students essay and completing two letters of recommendation from external, non-relative sources.

**Students will only be awarded one scholarship/tuition waiver from USU Tooele Regional Campus for the academic year 09-10. If a student is eligible for more than one scholarship/waiver, only the one with the greatest monetary value will be awarded.

To qualify for this award, students must:

1. Apply for and be officially admitted to Utah State University by application deadline of July 31, 2009.
2. Submit official transcripts to Utah State University for articulation and posting.
3. Show a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
4. Submit a personal type-written essay, not to exceed 500 words with your application; address your life experience; financial need; educational goals; and service/volunteer history.
5. Submit two sealed letters of recommendation from non-relative, external sources with the application.
6. Maintain enrollment in a minimum of 6 credits each semester during scholarship period at USU Tooele Regional Campus (repeated courses as well as independent study courses do not qualify).
7. Complete and submit this application to USU Tooele Regional Campus on or before July 31, 2009.

To maintain this award, students must:

1. Maintain enrollment in a minimum of 6 credits both semesters at a USU Tooele Regional Campus (repeated courses as well as independent study courses do not qualify).
2. Remain in good standing and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

Restrictions of the award:

1. Award cannot be used with any other USU Tooele Regional Campus scholarship or tuition waiver.
2. Award is good for Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 semesters only.
3. Award is not redeemable for cash refund.
4. Award **will be** reversed and the student will owe the balance if enrolled credits drop below 6 each semester.
5. Award will discontinue if the cumulative GPA drops below 2.5.
6. Recipient must meet with a Tooele Regional Campus Advisor prior to the award being disbursed.
7. Recipient must compose a thank you letter to this scholarship's sponsor to be reviewed with the Tooele Regional Campus Advisor prior to the award being disbursed.
