



# Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship Information & Qualifications USU Tooele Regional Campus

## Information

Summer 2009 Only

The Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship is awarded to students whose ability to afford college has been impaired due to diminished family income and/or extreme financial stressors. Economically Disadvantaged Scholarships are available only to students who qualify for Federal Financial Aid. **Students who have a low Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) number on their Student Aid Report (SAR) may be awarded the Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship.** The EFC number is calculated after students apply for Federal Financial Aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. **In the event that two or more students are in the same EFC bracket the applications will be considered based on GPA and completed credits.**

This scholarship is available to new, returning, or continuing USU Tooele Regional Campus undergraduate students. The Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship is only available to students who attend the USU Tooele Regional Campus and cannot be transferred to Utah State University in Logan or any other Regional Campus or Education Center. The Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship may be used with other scholarships, waivers, or awards, but this scholarship has no cash surrender value. In order to be awarded the scholarship a student must have a financial aid unmet need amount that allows the student to receive scholarship money for the semester the scholarship is awarded (according to Financial Aid guidelines). Students are not entitled to refunds of scholarship monies should they drop one or more classes during the registration refund deadline.

**To be considered for the Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship applicants must turn in a completed “Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship – Application Form” to Utah State University – Tooele Regional Campus by Wednesday, 29 April 2009 at 5:00 pm.**

**Applicants will be notified if they have received the Economically Disadvantaged Scholarship and the scholarship amount by approximately 8 May 2009. The amount awarded for the scholarship is determined by the funds available for the scholarship and the number of people who apply for the scholarship.**

## Qualifications

1. Completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form for the 2008-2009 Academic Year (<http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>)
2. Completion of all USU Financial Aid supplemental paperwork and procedures. Completed financial aid information must be posted in USU Banner (USU database) by the date the application form is due.
3. Academic transcript must be submitted with application.
4. Applicants must be officially admitted to USU by the date the application form is due.
5. Students must be enrolled in summer 2009 courses at USU Tooele Regional Campus by the date the application deadline.
6. Students must enroll and maintain 6 or more credit hours for the summer 2009 semester.
7. Incomplete application forms will not be considered.
8. Awarded students agree to have a registration hold placed on their account at the time of the award. Any changes to a student's class schedule after the award date must be coordinated with the Business Officer at USU Tooele Regional Campus. **The award will be completely reversed if a student's attempted credit hours fall below six credit hours during the session/semester.**
